Supporting Entrepreneurship in Education (SEED) is a business plan competition for early-stage education entrepreneurs in Philadelphia. In its fifth year, SEED has given out more than \$20,000 in prizes and provided applicants with an opportunity to present their ideas before an engaged audience of potential funders, users, collaborators, and community members.

The SEED 5.0 Finalists

BRIDGE empowers K-12 students by cultivating self-efficacy tools via a curriculum centered on yoga, mindfulness, writing and community building.

Make Your Name Great, Inc. assists minority high school students in applying life skills to ensure college success.

Math4Fun Cognitive Camps (M4F Cog Camps) iM4F Cog Camps support caregivers & early-childhood educators in knowing stages of and promoting children's mathematical development.

Math Corps Philadelphia is a Philadelphia urban youth transcending the math achievement gap, going from F to A/B.

Rebel Ventures is a youth-run job-training social enterprise with a mission to make good food and good food education available to everyone.

SmartTrack helps educators scan and track learning resources, preventing unnecessary loss and keeping them in students' hands.

The Teacher Place is a "store" where teachers from under-resourced Philly schools can get free supplies for their students and classrooms.

Toolbox for Teachers promotes educator resiliency via trainings in mindfulness, trauma-informed education & social-emotional competencies.


